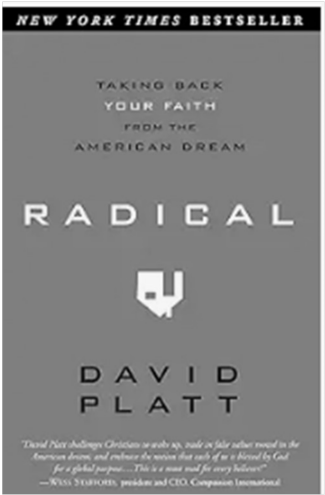
- Small Tents
